Dog Walks & Parks

● **MISSION DOLORES PARK** • Both pet owners and their dogs will enjoy this park, which offers good weather, beautiful views and interesting people-watching. Several food and shopping options are nearby on 18th St. and Castro St.

The park is located at Dolores St. & 18th St. in the Castro and is two blocks long by one block wide. Park features a North dog play area.

● **FORT FUNSTON** • Regarded as the best dog park in San Francisco, the beautiful scenery consists of high bluffs, ocean views and large sand dunes. Pet owners will enjoy a historical walk while dogs run free or swim in the ocean.

The park is located at Fort Funston Road & Skyline Boulevard, just south of Ocean Beach and Lake Merced and is over 35 acres. Dogs are allowed off-leash under voice control.

● **THE PRESIDIO** • The Presidio is the perfect park to visit for pet owners looking for beautiful ocean views or uncrowded hikes through small, wooded areas. Recommended routes are the Environmental Trail loop to Inspiration Point, Crissy Field or Baker Beach.

The Presidio is located at Arguello Boulevard & Moraga Ave and is 1,491 acres with over 11 miles of trails. Most trails are open to dogs on-leash. Off-leash dogs are allowed at a few places such as Lands End, Baker Beach north of Lobos Creek, & Crissey Field Beach from May 15-July 1 only.

● **JESSIE SQUARE** • The perfect place to meet local dogs and humans alike, Jessie square features green lawns and wooden benches. The space also features a pedestrian corridor filled with shops and restaurants for owners looking to do more exploring. Jessie Square is located at 736 Mission Street. Dogs must be on-leash and waste bags are required.

● **SUE BIERMAN PARK** • Featuring beautiful views of the Ferry Building and the Bay Bridge, Sue Bierman Park offers 5.3 acres of recreational space in the Financial District. The park is a great location for a picnic and is also close to several tourist attractions.

Sue Bierman Park is located at 216 Drumm Street. Dogs must be on-leash and waste bags are required.

● **HUNTINGTON PARK** • Located on Nob Hill, Huntington Park is a quiet, manicured green space by Grace Cathedral. The park features a designated dog area and benches for owners to relax

Huntington Park is located at California Street & Cushman Street. Dogs must be on-leash and waste bags are required.
